

Infection Control Statement

We aim to keep our practice clean and tidy and offer a safe environment to our patients and staff. We are proud of our modern purpose-built medical centre and endeavour to make sure it is kept clean and maintained.

Our staff follow our infection control policy to ensure the care we deliver, and the equipment we use is safe.

We take additional measures to ensure we maintain the highest standards:

- Encourage staff and patients to raise any issues or incidents relating to cleanliness and infection control. We discuss these and identify any necessary improvements to avoid future issues.
- Carry out an annual infection control audit to ensure our infection control procedures are effective.
- Provide rolling staff training to ensure all staff are fully aware of all infection control procedures.
- Review the infection control policy and procedures annually to ensure they are adequate and meet current national guidelines.
- Maintain the premises and equipment to a high standard, within the available financial resources.
- Ensure all reasonable steps are taken to remove or reduce all infection risk.
- Use disposable materials for items such as couch rolls, modesty curtains etc, and ensure these are changed regularly as per current guidelines.

Significant Events

There have been no significant events relating to infection control in the past year.

Audits

An annual infection control audit was undertaken at the practice on the 10/02/2026 carried out by the infection control lead, Jessica Pierre. All recommendations have been implemented at the practice.

Cleaning Specifications

The daily cleaning of the practice is contracted to an outside company. The cleaning staff work to a structured daily cleaning schedule.

Infection Control policy

The infection control policy was last updated 27/02/2026. This policy will be reviewed annually or before as national guidance changes.
